IMPORTANT NOTE:

Philippine Airlines and United Airlines are totally unrelated and are individual airline tickets. A night pre & post the trip have been included due to this, though there is still a risk of mis-connection due to weather, airline operational issues etc. Therefore any mis-connections can mean a re-purchase of another airline ticket at your own expense.

As of 22 July 2023, the Philippine Government has removed all COVID-19 travel requirements. You will still need to check for any requirements for travel of your airline and onward destinations.

It is strongly recommended that you still travel with a copy of your official International Covid-19 Vaccination Certificate.

Foreign nationals from visa-free countries who are traveling to the Philippines for business and tourism purposes are allowed to enter the Philippines without visas for a stay not exceeding thirty (30) days, provided they hold valid tickets for their return journey to port of origin or next port of destination and their passports valid for a period of at least six (6) months beyond the contemplated period of stay.

PRE-DEPARTURE REQUIREMENTS:

It is mandatory to register your traveller information at <https://etravel.gov.ph/> within 72 hours prior to arrival from port of embarkation to get a QR Code.

As of 08 January 2024, the Philippines Bureau of Customs' Baggage Declaration Form and the Currency Declaration Form are now integrated into the E-Travel System, along with the Bureau of Quarantine's Health Declaration Form and the Bureau of Immigration's Departure and Arrival Cards.

Take a screenshot or download your personal QR Code before closing or exiting the **eTravel** website or application AND/OR print your QR code. You will be required to show this QR code to an airline representative before being allowed to board your flight. Upon arrival in the Philippines, you must present this QR code or barcode to the BOQ Quarantine officers for verification.

The following are the documents to be submitted:

- a) Proof of vaccination (except for children below 15 years old, who will follow the protocol for the accompanying parent or guardian)
- b) Confirmed bookings from hotels or accommodation establishments that are accredited by the Philippines' Department of Tourism (DOT)
- c) Return flight tickets to your port of origin or next destination, which should be not later than 30 days from date of arrival in the Philippines

NOTE:

* Scuba equipment has been included on the Prohibited Items List of Blunt Instruments by the Philippines Office for Transportation Security and should only be packed in your checked baggage for flights originating in the Philippines. We advise that all guests carry all dive related equipment in their checked luggage rather than their carry-on.

Guam is an unincorporated US territory. You must meet US entry or transit requirements.

Australia, New Zealand and 38 other countries are a participating country of the visa waiver program which allows travel to the United States for business or tourism for stays of up to 90 days without a visa. * To apply for ESTA entry to the USA and its territories (including Guam) under the visa waiver program please go to <https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov> A travel authority is required to be applied for at least 72 hours prior to departure or boarding will be denied.

Current cost is USD\$21 per person (subject to change).

If you are asked for a higher fee, you are most likely not on the official US Government website.

GUAM ELECTRONIC DECLARATION FORM

The Guam Electronic Declaration Form (Guam EDF) is a mandatory digital form that all arriving passengers will need to complete before entering our beautiful island. For your safety and convenience, the form will be accessible up to 72 hours prior to your arrival.

ENTRY AND TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS TO TRUK LAGOON (FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA)

Proof of COVID-19 vaccination is no longer required for entry unless the traveller is coming from an infected area.

Non-citizens with valid passport and onward ticket can enter the FSM for 30 days or less without an entry permit. Upon arrival, all non-citizens without a valid entry permit must present a completed "Customs, Immigration & Quarantine Form (CIQ Form)." This form is furnished by a carrier prior to arrival at the point of entry.

* A local Truk departure tax of USD \$30 needs to be paid on departure in USD cash at the airport (subject to change).

* ATM's are not always available in the FSM. Please carry some USD cash.

* Please note the destination you have chosen is in a fairly remote location. Therefore, accommodation standards / facilities and service levels may not quite be as you would expect in comparison to western standards. For example, internet connections may be very slow or non-existent, mobile reception may be sporadic or non-existent, televisions if present in your room may not have many choices for channel selection. Often choices for fresh food are limited or hard to come by due to transportation issues and things often happen on "island time". We remind you to bear these considerations in mind when traveling to remote destinations to ensure your expectations are on par with what can feasibly be delivered. It is also these considerations that make your chosen destination so special and different.
