## **\*\* INTERNATIONAL PROCEDURES \*\***

Please note that check-in for International flights is 3 hours prior to departure and for domestic flights 90 minutes prior to departure.

Reconfirmation of your flight time 24-48 hours prior to departure with the airlines is critical to ensure there are no last minute schedule changes before departure.

Please check your passport for a minimum of 6 months validity from intended date of return and that two blank pages are available.

#### The following is an example of the day-to-day itinerary

**Day 1:** Embarkation time is dependant on flight arrival times. When all guests are on board introductions, boat and safety briefings will be conducted after which guets can set up their gear or relax before dinner is served. The vessel will generally depart port at some point through the evening to be ready to dive first thing on day 2. There is no diving on embarkation day.

**Day 2:** Breakfast followed by a check dive, and up to 3 subsequent dives, as outlined below.

## Days 3-5

Your Cruise Director will schedule up to 4 dives per day; 3 day dives and either a sunset or a night dive.

A typical diving day is scheduled as follows:

- Light Breakfast followed by a briefing & Dive 1
- Full Breakfast, relaxation followed by briefing & Dive 2
- Lunch, relaxation followed by briefing & Dive 3
- Snack
- Briefing for Sunset or Night dive
- Dinner

#### Day before disembarkation:

For your last full day on board, we are able to schedule 3 dives\* before the boat cruises back to Labuan Bajo, where it will remain at anchor overnight.

**Disembarkation day:** Following breakfast on board, disembarkation is scheduled between 8:00am and 10:00am.

\*We kindly request that guests check their flight departure times to ensure that they leave a minimum of 24 hours between their final dive and their flight home.

## Minimum dive certification and experience:

Divers are required to have Advanced Open Water certification\*, or equivalent, with a minimum of 50 logged dives.

\*Advanced Open Water courses can be completed on board.

Guests who do not fulfil the minimum certification and experience requirements may be denied participation in some or all dives. We have 3 permanent dive guides on board to enable small dive groups of 5-6.
