We recommend that this insurance covers SCUBA diving to 40m as a minimum as well as any other SCUBA activities that are confirmed in your itinerary or you may reasonable expect to be carrying out as part of your booking;
- \* Medical Evacuation Insurance: covering all risks, costs and expenses likely to arise from a diving injury or necessitating your evacuation to a place of specialist care, including but not limited to low altitude air evacuation; specialist treatment and direct; and indirect losses; and
- \* Travel Insurance.

You must be satisfied that your insurance fully covers all your personal requirements including pre-existing medical conditions, cancellation charges, medical expenses and repatriation in the event of accident or illness, diving injuries and medical evacuation. If you choose to travel without adequate insurance cover, we will not be liable for any losses howsoever arising, in respect of which insurance cover would otherwise have been available.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:**

The provision of activities during your holiday is dependent on you being medically fit to participate in the activities. You are strongly advised to undergo a full medical examination before your holiday.

We reserve the right to prevent your participation in any activities if you are deemed medically unfit to do so or in our sole discretion, you are not fit to participate in the activities.

If, as part of your holiday, you will be SCUBA diving, you are required to complete a medical questionnaire upon arrival at the resort, available in advance at

<https://masterliveboards.com/forms>. If we are unsure as to your fitness to SCUBA dive, you may be required to undergo a medical examination locally.

If you hold a diving medical certificate, a copy of the certificate should be taken on your holiday.

## **\*\* INTERNATIONAL PROCEDURES \*\***

Please note that check-in for International flights is 3 hours prior to departure and for domestic flights 90 minutes prior to departure.

Reconfirmation of your flight time 24-48 hours prior to departure with the airlines is critical to ensure there are no last minute schedule changes before departure.

Please check your passport for a minimum of 6 months validity from intended date of return and that two blank pages are available.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You can get a visa exemption for up to 30 days if you arrive through one of the international airports or for up to 15 days if you enter through a land border (restricted to 2 entries per calendar year). Entry and exit conditions can change at short notice. You should contact the nearest embassy or consulate of Thailand or see the Thai government's Facebook page for the latest details.

You no longer need to apply for permission to enter Thailand (previously known as a Thailand Pass), show proof of COVID-19 vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test result.

Insurance coverage for COVID-19 is no longer mandatory, but insurance is highly recommended, as Thailand continues to experience local transmission of COVID-19. If you're visiting Thailand and then travelling to a country that requires COVID-19 testing (RAT or PCR test) for entry, you'll need to purchase medical insurance prior to your arrival in Thailand. The insurance will need to provide cover for COVID-19 treatment.

### National Marine Park Fees

All visitors to Mu Ko Similan and Mu Ko Surin National Marine Parks will be required to pay a fee of THB 500 per entry plus THB 200 per day spent in the Marine Park.

A maximum of 525 visitors are permitted in the National Marine Parks per day. Entry tickets are sold on a "first come, first served basis" (subject to availability). Advance booking is strongly recommended to avoid disappointment.

The following information is now required for all guests at time of booking in order to apply for and purchase the entry tickets:

- Full name as printed in your passport
- Date of birth DD/MM/YYYY
- Nationality (as printed in your passport)
- Passport Number

Please also note that diving insurance is now mandatory. Guests will be required to present a paper copy of diving insurance confirmation and diving certification. Failure to produce these documents on inspection by park rangers could lead to guests being barred from diving. Note that digital copies on a phone or tablet will not be accepted.

Day 1: Embarkation at 19:00 followed by briefings and dinner

Days 2-5: Up to 4 dives, scheduled as follows

- Light Breakfast followed by a briefing and Dive 1
- Full Breakfast, relaxation period, briefing and Dive 2
- Lunch, relaxation period, briefing and Dive 3
- Snack relaxation period, briefing and Dive 4, where possible
- Dinner

Day 7: Disembarkation at 10:00
