** INTERNATIONAL PROCEDURES **

Please note that check-in for International flights is 3 hours prior to departure and for domestic flights 90 minutes prior to departure.

Reconfirmation of your flight time 24-48 hours prior to departure with the airlines is critical to ensure there are no last minute schedule changes before departure.

Please check your passport for a minimum of 6 months validity from intended date of return and that two blank pages are available.

SOLOMON ISLANDS TRAVEL INFO (subject to change - check for the latest updates prior to travel)

Most tourists will be issued a short stay visitors permit on arrival to the Solomon Islands. Citizens of the Commonwealth, the United States and the majority of European countries do not require a visa upon arrival. All other foreign nationals should apply for a holiday and/or working visa before entry to the Solomons.

Effective 23 May 2023, all incoming travellers to Solomon Islands no longer need to provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination or COVID-19 test (either PCR or Rapid Antigen Test) unless requested. However, passengers arriving into the destination will still be required to complete a health declaration card which will be made available on board arriving aircraft or at point of entry into the destination.

You are encouraged to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. It's recommended you carry your COVID-19 vaccination and relevant health documentation with you when travelling.

MONEY MATTERS

International credit cards may be accepted at major hotels, resorts and large shops in Honiara. Credit card facilities are not readily available elsewhere. You can change currency and access ATM's at Honiara Airport and commercial banks in Honiara and Gizo. It is recommended you take Solomon Dollars and some Australian Dollars if you would like to purchase local souvenirs, snacks and drinks etc.

DIVING EMERGENCIES

There is a hyperbaric chamber in Honiara operated by on-call volunteers. Medical complications resulting from scuba diving accidents may require specialised evacuation transport to Australia or New Zealand. Please ensure you have DAN membership/insurance or other travel insurance that includes emergency medical evacuation cover for scuba diving related incidents.

* Please note the destination you have chosen is in a fairly remote location. Therefore, accommodation standards / facilities and service levels may not quite be as you would expect in comparison to western standards. For example, internet connections may be very slow or non-existent, mobile reception may be sporadic or non-existent, televisions if present in your room may not have many choices for channel selection. Often choices for fresh food are limited or hard to come by due to transportation issues and things often happen on "island time". We remind you to bear these considerations in mind when traveling to remote destinations to ensure your expectations are on par with what can feasibly be delivered. It is also these considerations that make your chosen destination so special and different.
