INSURANCE:

Adequate diving and travel insurance is a condition of your contract with us including:

* Dive Injury Insurance: covering all risks, costs, and expenses likely to be incurred as a result of a diving injury, including but not limited to re-compression chamber treatments, air evacuation, and loss or damage to possessions. We recommend that this insurance covers SCUBA diving to 40m as a minimum as well as any other SCUBA activities that are confirmed in your itinerary or you may reasonable expect to be carrying out as part of your booking

* Medical Evacuation Insurance: covering all risks, costs and expenses likely to arise from a diving injury or necessitating your evacuation to a place of specialist care, including but not limited to low altitude air evacuation; specialist treatment and direct; and indirect losses; and

* Travel Insurance

You must be satisfied that your insurance fully covers all your personal requirements including pre-existing medical conditions, cancellation charges, medical expenses and repatriation in the event of accident or illness, diving injuries and medical evacuation. If you choose to travel without adequate insurance cover, we will not be liable for any losses howsoever arising, in respect of which insurance cover would otherwise have been available.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

The provision of activities during your holiday is dependent on you being medically fit to participate in the activities. You are strongly advised to undergo a full medical examination before your holiday. We reserve the right to prevent your participation in any activities if you are deemed medically unfit to do so or in our sole discretion, you are not fit to participate in the activities.

If, as part of your holiday, you will be SCUBA diving, you are required to complete a medical questionnaire upon arrival at the resort, available in advance at <https://masterliveboards.com/forms>. If we are unsure as to your fitness to SCUBA dive, you may be required to undergo a medical examination locally. If you hold a diving medical certificate, a copy of the certificate should be taken on your holiday.

DIVE QUALIFICATION/DIVE EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

You will be required to present the qualification card(s) and recent log book(s) upon check-in onto the vessel to prove your Mandatory or Recommended dive qualifications and experience.

**** INTERNATIONAL PROCEDURES ****

Please note that check-in for International flights is 3 hours prior to departure and for domestic flights 1.5 - 2 hours prior to departure.

Please check your passport for a minimum of 6 months validity from intended date of return and that two blank pages are available.

- Effective April 25th, 2023, Palau will no longer require COVID-19 vaccination to enter the country.

- The **Palau Entry Form** must be completed online **within 72 hours or less prior to your arrival time** into the Republic of Palau at <https://palautravel.pw/>

Only ONE form is required per family or per single traveler. A copy will be emailed to you after you submit your form. Save a copy of the email as well as your generated QR code to expedite your entry verification upon arrival in Palau.

- All visitors must have a valid passport not less than 6 months from date of expiration and proof of return arrangements. A 30-day Tourist Visa will be issued upon arrival.

* As part of Palau's Responsible Tourism Education Act, reef-toxic sunscreens are banned in Palau. Travellers should take reef-safe, non-nano mineral based sunscreens into Palau.

* It is illegal to bring and use e-cigarettes and vapes in Palau.
